

The Dreams Project- TBRS

Aim- The Dreams Project was set up with the sole purpose of encouraging and inspiring students to find something they love, and follow their dream, through the use of school visits assemblies and workshops. The dreams project hopes to motivate students to discover and follow their dreams.

The Dreams Project School Visit is split into 2 section. (Info about both sections are listed below)

Requirements- in order to receive a visit from Tom to deliver The Dreams Project:

- You must be a school, or a place of education. The dreams project is designed for Primary and Secondary schools but has been adapted to suit college students too.
- Have a minimum take up of 20 students for Section 2 (Read below for details on section 2)
- Section 1 should take place in the afternoon for a duration of around 50 mins (school timings dependent)
- Both Section 1 and Section 2 will take place on the same day and the expectation is section 1 is dependent on section 2 running.

Section 1 (Assembly)- The assembly can be delivered to any group size from a single class all the way to the entire school, depending on what the school desires. This assembly will last around 50 mins (fully dependent on the schools lesson structure and timings). These assemblies should take place in the afternoon during a lesson or afternoon assemble slot. The school should be able to provide a hall or classroom to deliver this assembly with the following technical requirements.

- Projector / Interactive Whiteboard (Powerpoint and Videos)
- Audio system (To Play Music)

Below is a guide to the assembly's content and structure, however each assembly will vary or differ slightly, depending on the age group, assembly size, and time.

- Introductory video
- Warm Up Game/Song (Interactive)
- Welcome from Tom Ball
- Discussing Dreams (Interactive)
- Tom Ball's story
- Lessons to be Learnt
- Learning a song / performing a song (Interactive)
- Q&A (Time dependent)

Section 2 (Workshop)- This section is for students with a specific interest in music, singing and drama and will be an extra-curricular opportunity. This could take place either at lunch or preferably after school to give maximum time and focus to the students. (To be delivered the same day as section 1) This particular section should be offered to students at a cost of £20 for a 1 hour workshop. This workshop will run on the provision that a minimum of 25 students sign up at £20 per head. This expense goes towards travel, administration, and insurance costs, and schools are welcome to contact regarding school funding or grants to cover necessary expenditure. Payments can be taken before and on the day of either by transfer, cash or cheque. (To be collected by the school)

Below is a guide to the workshops offered (the content of this workshop is open to discussion based on what the school is currently offering- ie. School musicals, Drama / Music clubs to help and provide impactful education and support) The workshop content can include but are not limited to

- Singing Health and Support
- Acting Through Song
- Learning A Musical Number
- Audition Technique
- Working As An Ensemble

- Character Workshop
- Singing Technique
